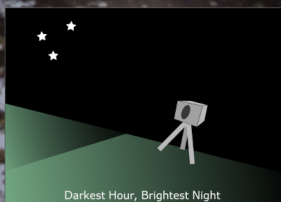

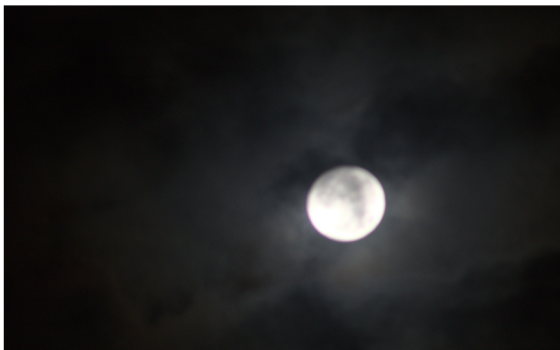

With darkness finally winning

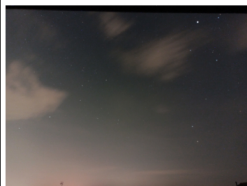
Moonheads

Photograph the Moon

Photographing the Moon is one of the easier night objects to photograph. Whether it is with your phone camera, or a DSLR

It is usually best to try and photograph when the moon has some reasonable brightness. Say when it is at least half a Moon

Set the ISO reasonable low. Although this may depend on our camera or phone

Set the shutter speed to a quick speed

Then point, and photograph

Adjust the shutter speed, to ensure the Moons brightness, doesn't cause problems

And just shoot, adjust, and shoot again

This will give you some experience of night time shooting. Providing you are shooting at night

Is it possible to smell other planets?

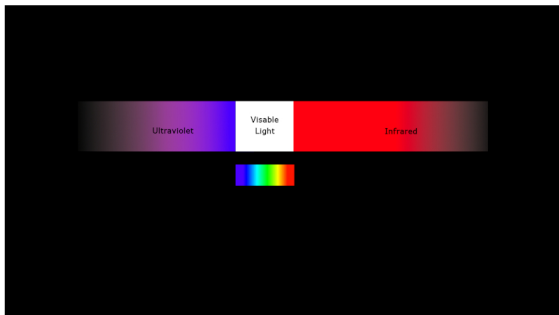
I'm afraid not, unless your standing on them

The Light Spectrum

If you are looking to view the spectrum of light outside, what is known as visible light. Then you may have trouble

The light spectrum is a measurement how long the peaks, or troughs, are between energy



The ultraviolet range has shorter wavelength, which increase to the visible light spectrum.

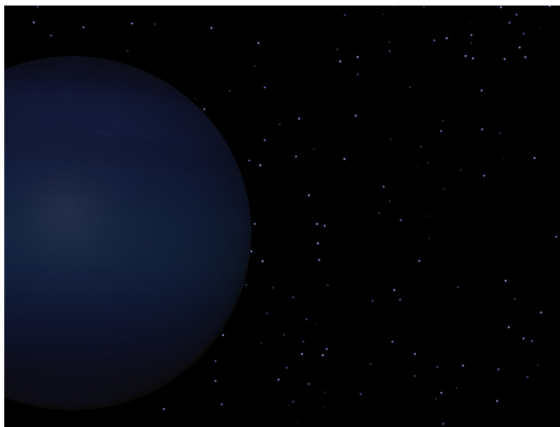
Which we can see

To the longer length infrared

These expand and either lend of the ultraviolet and infrared range, to the gamma rays after the UV wavelength, and radiowave after the infrared

On a day to day bases, you will only see the visible light spectrum

They have existe there for centuaries, having first arrived with the first arrival

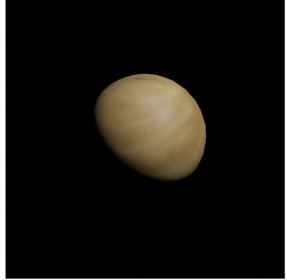
They are rarely seen, exept when they are out searching for food or a mate

So if you decide to try and spot,

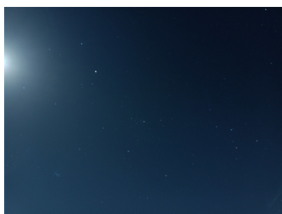
